Call for abstracts

This exceptional year the African Economic History Network is forced to postpone its regular annual meeting. It is replaced with a series of smaller regional meetings and the **Department of Economic History at Lund University** will host one of them on **21-22 October 2021**.

The aim of the meeting is to provide **PhD-students and early career scholars based at European Universities** an opportunity to present their work. We are inviting submissions in all fields of African economic history.

The abstract should not be longer than 500 words and should be submitted together with a CV to erik.green@ekh.lu.se by **1 August 2021**.

Applicants will be notified if they have been accepted or not, no later than 15 August 2021. A limited number of non-presenting participants can be allowed, but they would have to state specific reasons to the organisers.

The plan is to organize the meeting on campus at Lund University. Due to the uncertain times we currently live in, we may have to decide to hold the meeting on Zoom or a hybrid between the two. A final decision regarding the format will be made and communicated early September 2021.
