Furthermore, qualifying full papers will be considered for publication in a special issue in The International Review of Retail, Distribution and Consumer Research.

Please submit a two-page abstract (750-1000 words) on the NRWA website (www.nrwa.se) no later than May 13 2024. Submissions must be in English. Abstracts will be arranged by tracks according to common interests. Delegates will be notified of the acceptance of their papers by June 14.
